AND UPON READING the Certificate of Urgency and the Fixed Date Claim Form filed on the 6th day of June 2023 and the supporting Affidavit of Mr. Paul Prescod in the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions, State Counsel (ag.) sworn and filed on the 6th day of June 2023 together with the Exhibits attached thereto;

AND UPON DETERMINING that this matter be deemed fit for an urgent hearing.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED: that Pursuant to sections 9(1)(a) of the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34, the Defendants, listed on 5th day of 2023 Security Council Press June as per the Release 14767https://www.interpol.int/en/How-we-work/Notices/View-UN-Notices-Individuals, listed on the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List concerning ISIL (DA'ESH) and Al-Qaida and designated by the United Nations Security Council 1267/1989/2253 Committee be removed from the list as entities or other groups for the purposes of the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- 1. Service of this Order be dispensed with;
- 2. Pursuant to section 9(2)(a) and (b)of the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019-34 to restore:
 - (a) any property of any nature whatsoever whether immovable or movable of the persons against whom the Terrorist Designation Order is made;
 - (b) property that is wholly or jointly owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the persons against whom the Terrorist Designation Order and the Counter Proliferation Order are made;
 - (c) property that is derived or generated from other property owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the persons against whom the Terrorist Designation Order and the Counter Proliferation Order are made;

- (d) property of persons acting on behalf of, or at the direction of, the persons against whom the Terrorist Designation Order and the Counter Proliferation Order are made;
- 3. The Registrar of the Supreme Court do serve an Office Copy of the Order on the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) immediately;
- 4. Pursuant to **section 10(1)** of the said **Act**, the Director of Public Prosecutions shall cause notice of this Order to be published electronically immediately and in the Official Gazette and in at least 2 daily newspapers in circulation in Barbados, as soon as possible;
- 5. Liberty to apply;
- 6. Costs to be costs in the cause; and
- 7. Such other Orders as this Honourable Court shall deem fit
